Transcripts	<p>Transcripts are mailed by the host school/faculty's departmental coordinator to the student and to the home university exchange coordinator after the completion of the student's exchange :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - in February for Fall semester - in June for Spring semester.
Academic Calendar	<p>The academic year is divided into 2 semesters.</p> <p>Each faculty and each school has its own academic calendar. The 2012/2013 academic calendars are usually available between March and May 2012.</p> <p><u>In the faculties :</u> Fall semester : from September to December/January Spring semester : from January to May/June</p> <p><u>In the schools/colleges :</u> Fall semester : from the end of August/September to December Spring semester : from January/February to June</p>

Please click on "AEU Housing"</p> <p><i>Please note :</i></p> <p><i>The International Office of UCL has no involvement in housing placements which are under the responsibility of AEU</i></p> <p>. Important : <i>According to French law, rentals run and are due:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - from August 1st to July 31st (Fall semester and academic year) even if the students arrive later in September - or from January 1st to July 31st (Spring Semester) even if the students arrive later in February. <p><u>Leaving your dorm</u> : 1 month before leaving your dorm, students must inform by e-mail the Housing Office : logement@aeu.asso.fr</p> <p><i>.
