

Spoken production:

I can present clear, detailed descriptions of complex subjects integrating subthemes, developing particular points and rounding off with an appropriate conclusion.

I can express myself in clear, well structured text, expressing points of view at some length. I can write about complex subjects in letter, an essay or a report, underlining what I consider to be the salient issues. I can select style appropriate to the reader in mind.

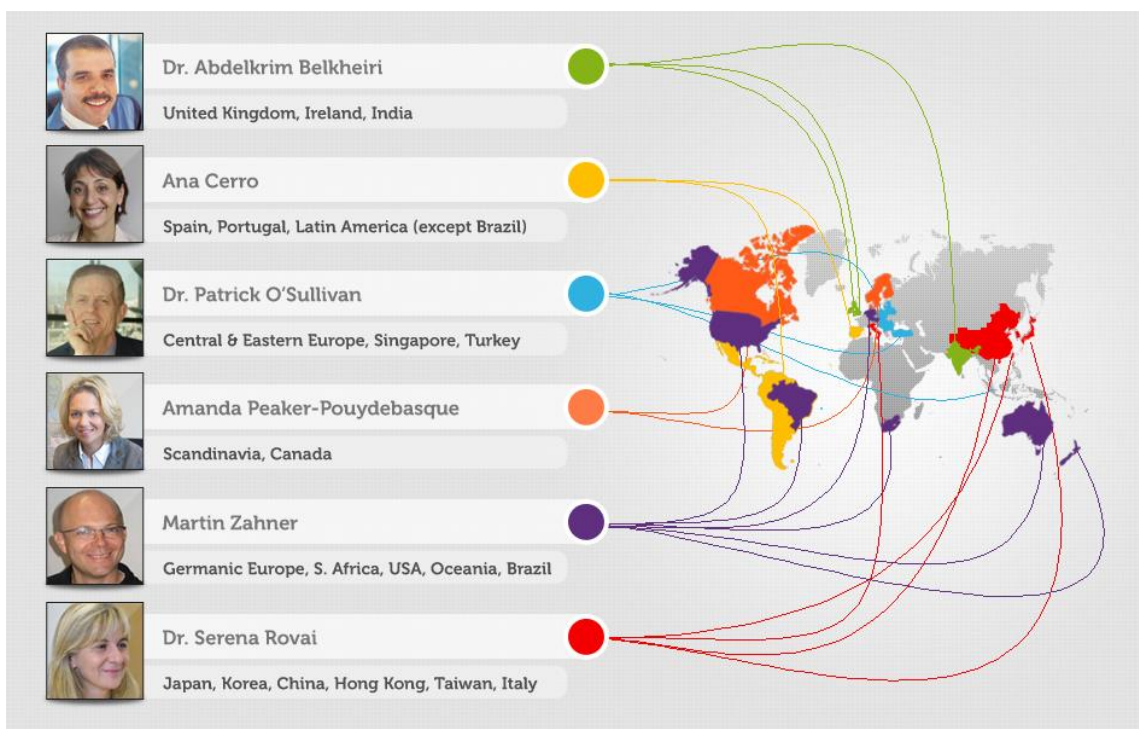

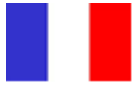
